FEES, EXPENSES, & FINANCIAL AID

Give careful consideration to the total financing of your university education. If you need funds beyond those that you and your family can provide, you should apply for financial aid well in advance of enrollment. There are deadlines for applying for financial aid; grants, loans, Work Study and scholarships.

Every student must pay the quarterly fees, and any amounts charged to the student account, in full by the fee payment deadlines in the Fees & Billing calendar (https://registrar.ucdavis.edu/calendar/fees/). A Deferred Payment Plan (DPP) (https://afs.ucdavis.edu/student-resources/accounting/mybill/dpp/) is available, allowing students to pay quarterly tuition & fees, health insurance, document, orientation, international, equitable access and housing fees in three monthly installments, or semester fees in four monthly installments.
